Ref. : 1. This office letter No. 69/HOPCB/Pur/F-512 dated 04.03.2022.

2. Several communications by this office during past two years.

This is to draw your immediate attention to the aforesaid subject for sustained violations and exceptional disregard to the Terms & Conditions stated in the above referred letter. It is regretted to note that even after three years of installation of Real-time Ambient Noise Monitoring Systems (RTANMS) by your firm at Bhopal the streamlining of real-time data have not been complied, as per conditions laid down, till date defeating the basic purpose of monitoring. It has also been brought to my notice that the situation is persisting despite several reminders from this office.

The following principal lackings have been reported at your end :

1. The noise monitoring data should be stored directly in the MPPCB's database but it is not complying. Contrary to this it is still being sourced from your firm's database.
2. Provision of simplified API is there for transmission of data directly to the MPPCB's database but your firm has failed to do so.
3. Data is under your control posing risk of potential manipulation and is susceptible to raise doubt on reliability and integrity of data. This undermines transparency and accountability too for regulatory compliance.
4. The process of accessing and scheduling bulk data from your portal is complex and time consuming.


The above stated lackings, despite several reminders, is a serious matter as the noise pollution has a direct influence on the environment and health of the people. Owing to this the office has taken a strong note in the matter and may initiate action against the firm for the stated misdeeds. Copy of few of the previous communications is attached in this support.

You are hereby given an opportunity to make representation by submitting clarification as why action for blacklisting and barring commercial activities in Madhya Pradesh State should not be taken against your firm for the stated lapses and poor execution of post installation

tasks of RTANMS. Your reply should reach to this office within 15 days time from the issuance of this letter failing to taht the MPPCB shall be compelled and will be free to initiate suitable action, within the statutory framework, against the firm.
