Sub: Implementation of MSIHC Ruls 1989 and the CA (EPPR) Rules 1996.

Ref.: 1. Integrated Guidance Framework for Chemicals Safety in Respect of the Isolated Storages and Industries Covered Under Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals (MSIHC) Rules, 1989 published by the CPCB on 24.12.2021.

2. The Order passed by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal on 11.06.2021 in Original Application No. 60/2021.

The Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemicals Rules 1989 and the Chemical Accidents (EPR) Rules 1996 are already in force since long. It is hoped that all the regulatory norms under the said rules are being complied under your jurisdiction to meet the set objectives of industrial safety and well being of the people and the environment. In view of this, and as part of industrial safety review process, the following information under your jurisdiction is required on an urgent note:

- 1. Names of industries falling under Isolated Storage criteria as per Rule 2(e) of MSIHC Rules, 1989.
- 2. Names of industries importing hazardous chemicals as per provision under Rule 18 of MSIHC Rules, 1989.
- 3. Status of district crisis groups (DCG) alongwith address and contact number of members of DCG as per Chemical Accidents (EPPR) Rules 1996.
- 4. Status of local crisis groups (LCG) alongwith address and contact number of members of LCG as per Chemical Accidents (EPPR) Rules 1996.

The requested information is expected from your end within 07 days time for review and onward necessary action.
