Sub.: Connectivity of OCEMS on New Portal 'ODAMS' of CPCB - reg.

Ref.: CPCB Directions issued vide letter no. IT-11/2021-IT-CPCB/5585, dated 23.09.2025.

The Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has issued directions u/s 18(1)(b) of Water (Prevention & Contol of Pollution) Act 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Contol of Pollution) Act 1981 for on-boarding of industries on new OCEMS Portal, i.e. Online Data Acquisition and Management System (ODAMS), launched on 31.08.2025.

The ODAMS has feature of direct transmission of datafrom the industries to the CPCB server without any dependency on TPDS, PTZ camera integration, Data analysis and visualization, revised calibration protocol implementation. Geotagging, Generating alers etc. The industry is required to register on portal https://cems.cpcb.gov.in by filling requisite information. The User manual and API document etc, if required by industry, is also available on https://cems.cpcb.gov.in/#/p/login.

The <u>last date</u> for registration by industries on the CPCB portal is <u>15.11.2025</u>. In view of this pursue the industries and ensure that all the OCEMS industries under your jurisdiction comply the new mandate within the specified time. Send the compliance report of your jurisdiction to this office by 25.11.2025.

Sub: Directions under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 in the matter of on-boarding of industries to New OCEMS Portal of CPCB.

WHEREAS, under Section 17 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, one of the function of the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs)/Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) is to plan a comprehensive programme for the prevention, control or abatement of air pollution in the State/Union Territory and to secure the execution thereof; and

WHEREAS, under Section 16 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, one of the functions of the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), constituted under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 is to coordinate activities of the State Pollution Control Boards and Pollution Control Committees and to provide technical assistance and guidance to SPCBs / PCCs; and

WHEREAS, there is need to inculcate habit of self-monitoring mechanism within the industries for complying the prescribed standards and this can be achieved by the methods like installing online emission and effluent monitoring devices; and

WHEREAS, for strengthening the monitoring and compliance through self- regulatory mechanism, online emission and effluent monitoring systems need to be installed and operated by the industries on 'polluter pays principle'; and

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WHEREAS, directions u/s 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and u/s 18(1)(b) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 have been issued to all the SPCBs/PCCs on March 2, 2015 for further directing 17 categories of industries and common treatment facilities for installation of online continuous emission/effluent monitoring system (OCEMS); and

WHEREAS, CPCB vide directions dated 29.12.2017 u/s 18(1)(b) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 directed 4 SPCBs/PCCs namely- Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Haryana to direct all the Red category – air polluting industries located in 23 districts of National Capital Region and Delhi to install online continuous Stack Emission Monitoring Systems in red category – air polluting industries for the consented parameters mentioned in the consent to operate/authorisation and ensure connection of OCEMS with the servers of CPCB/SPCB/PCC within stipulated time frame; and

WHEREAS, CPCB vide directions dated 18.06.2019, directed the 4 SPCB/PCC of NCR to ensure closure of all medium and large-scale red category air polluting industries in NCR Delhi, which have not installed and connected online continuous stack emission monitoring systems with CPCB & SPCB/PCC servers.; and

WHEREAS, CPCB developed an OCEMS Portal in 2018 for capturing the real-time continuous emission and effluent data from industries, wherein data is transmitted from Industry to CPCB Servers through servers of third-party entities called TPDS (Technology Provider for Data Submission); and

WHEREAS, a New OCEMS Portal (namely ODAMS) has now been developed by CPCB, having features such as direct transmission of data from Industries to CPCB Servers without any dependency on TPDS, PTZ Camera Integration, Data Analytics and Visualization, without any dependency on TPDS, PTZ Camera Integration, Data Analytics and Visualization, Revised Calibration Protocol Implementation, Geotagging, Generating Alerts based on Revised OCEMS Alert Protocol etc. The New OCEMS Portal has been made live on 31-August-2025; and

WHEREAS, CPCB has issued directions dated 12.08.2025, for ensuring adherence to the revised OCEMS Protocol for calibration and alert generation, that will also be monitored the revised OCEMS Portal; and through the New OCEMS Portal;

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WHEREAS, a demonstration of the new portal has been given via VC on 03.09.2025 and 09.09.2025, to NCR-Delhi SPCB ROs and industries, respectively; and

WHEREAS, all industries/common facilities with OCEMS connectivity are required to register and connect to New OCEM S Portal of CPCB, by filling the required details, including location coordinates, categorisation, classification, station information, analyser information etc. at https://cems.cpcb.gov.in. The procedure to register on the new portal is also available on the aforesaid URL;

NOW, THEREFORE, in the exercise of the powers delegated under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 18(1)(b) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution), Act, 1981, it is hereby directed that all industries, that have installed OCEMS or require to install the same, under jurisdiction of respective SPCB/PCC, be directed to register and connect to New OCEMS Portal of CPCB as per the timelines given below:

- a. For Industries located in NCR-Delhi latest by 15.10.2025
- b. For all other industries latest by 15.11.2025

The SPCB/PCC shall also ensure compliance of the above in their, respective State/UT.

Further, the SPCB/PCC shall acknowledge the receipt of this direction and submit the "Action Taken Report" in compliance in line with the timeline given above within 15-days.
