Sub: Compliance of Direction issued by CPCB U/S 18(1) of Water Act vide letter no. A-19014/43/06-UPC-I/4638 dated 07.08.2020.

Ref.: CPCB reminder letter dated 28.09.2022, copy enclosed.

Your attention is drawn to the above referred letter, copy of which is attached herewith, for the compliance of directions of CPCB under section 18(1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act 1974 to ensure strengthening of monitoring mechanism for effective compliance through self-regulatory mechanism by installation of OCEMS at STPs. It is on the record that the STPs have been discharging environmental pollutants directly or indirectly into the water bodies which pose constant threat and cause adverse effect on the river water quality. In order to deal with this the following compliances were expected to be ensured in the given time-frame for installation of OCEMS in phase-wise manner for regular monitoring and to minimize the site inspections:

- 1. All the STPs, being operated in Million plus cities by Municipal Corporations or the concerned body were asked to install online effluent monitoring systems for the parameters namely pH, BOD, COD, TSS and Flow meter and provide connectivity with Central Server at MPPCB before 31.01.2021.
- 2. The STPs operating in other cities/towns by Municipal Corporations, local bodies or any other agency were supposed to install online effluent monitoring systems for pH, TSS, COD, BOD and Flow meter and provide connectivity with Central Server at MPPCB before 31.07.2021.
- 3. The STP operating authority/agency is supposed to ensure regular maintenance and operation of online monitoring systems installed at STP site with temper proof with facility for calibration.
- 4. The STP operators are supposed to follow the guidelines published by the CPCB for online monitoring purpose.

As the timeline is already over, it is hoped that all the STPs under your jurisdiction are complying the norms in true spirit. In view of this it is urged to submit the present status of installation and connectivity of OCEMS in STPs under your jurisdiction for review and to enable this office to send the Action Taken Report to the CPCB as part of compliance.
